History

In 1993, several community leaders saw a need for alternative revenue sources in La Porte ISD after the implementation of Chapter 41 of the Texas Education Code, commonly known as the "Robin Hood" plan. This law was established to provide court-mandated equitable school financing for all school districts in the state.

The La Porte Education Foundation (LPEF) was formed to help provide extras for classrooms. LPEF's mission is to enhance education by funding innovative, creative instructional projects for students and teachers in the La Porte Independent School District.

The goals of the La Porte Education Foundation are to ...

- > Serve as a catalyst for involving the community in education.
- Create an endowment to fund programs and activities.
- > Expand opportunities for all La Porte ISD students and teachers.



To date, LPEF has awarded more than \$2.6 million for grants and special projects to 2,000 teachers and administrators in La Porte ISD.

Ms. Kelli Llewellyn Jennie Reid Elementary School


Students are gaming in math classes at Jennie Reid Elementary and becoming fluent in math facts at the same time. The Explore Learning Reflex Program helps students master basic math facts in addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division by playing cloud-based games on laptops.

Reflex has been used in thousands of classrooms to successfully support students who are testing at grade-level, at-risk students, and students with special needs. Reports have also shown that Reflex helps close learning gaps and improve student performance in the classroom and on state assessments.

A key component of Reflex's effectiveness stems from its ability to take research-validated techniques for fluency development and customize both the content and method of these techniques for each student. The system continuously monitors students' response patterns for each fact under study and uses this data to differentiate instruction and adapt practice throughout a Reflex session. Students must answer math questions that reinforce things they have learned in class to advance to play the next game in the program.

In just one school year, progress reports and exams show that students have substantially increased their math facts.
